PHARP focuses on vulnerable people affected or displaced by armed conflicts especially in Rwanda, Burundi, Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Southern Sudan, Darfur and the Horn of Africa. PHARP has made major contributions in training project officers and coordinators of many humanitarian agencies, organizations, religious institutions, education institutions and community based organizations that target victims of conflicts and marginalized groups in the society. The core principle of PHARP is to restore broken relationships and foster post conflict holistic healing.

PHARP envisions the transformation of individuals and communities to live in holistic harmony with God, fellow human beings and the physical environment.

Our Mission is to foster Godly peace, healing and reconciliation in hurting communities through programmes on conflict transformation and post conflict reconstruction.

The strategy promoted by PHARP is to maximize programmes impact through interventions designed to build local capacity through participatory approaches, strengthening the community sense of ownership of the projects and promoting project sustainability.



OUR PROGRAMMES

Peace, Justice and Conflict Transformation

It addresses different aspects of peace building, justice, reconciliation, conflicts and dynamics of conflicts situations.

Education and Training

Initiates and facilitates dialogue that promotes reflection of the knowledge and experience from participants. This programmes also aims at developing training manuals applicable to needs of the target group.

Trauma Healing, Reconciliation and Discipleship

Focuses at different communication patterns and embarks on dimensions of exploring psychological processes leading to holistic healing and reconciliation.
